

Larkfield Oaks 5255 Fulton Road, Santa Rosa, California

Community Housing Sonoma County partnered with Burbank Housing Development Corporation to create this multi-family rental development for low-income singles, families, people living with disabilities, and agricultural workers. Through Community Housing Sonoma County's leadership, seven units are set aside as permanent supportive housing for persons with mental and/or developmental disabilities. Additionally, the special needs residents have vocational employment opportunities directly across the street in Sonoma County's first open space "urban farm" on a publicly designated open space property.
