

Stony Point Commons 2643 Stony Point Road, Santa Rosa, CA

Community Housing Sonoma County partnered with Burbank Housing Development Corporation in the acquisition and rehabilitation of this facility for very low-income residents living with mental illness. Each tenant has their own room (SRO unit) with individual lock and key, appliances (microwave and refrigerator), and access to shared community spaces, a large living room, dining room, and a community kitchen. Residents participate in weekly "house meetings" and are asked to do one hour of yard work per week on the beautiful grounds of this property.
