

Vida Nueva 705 Rohnert Park Expressway, Rohnert Park, California

Community Housing Sonoma County and Burbank Housing Development Corporation have constructed a new, 100 percent permanent supportive housing complex providing affordable housing and support services to formerly homeless families and individuals living with disabilities. A broad spectrum of services are provided, such as mental health and chemical dependency support, employment readiness, parenting education, and money management. Volunteer teams from the community, trained by The Family Connection program, give additional support to the families.
